That means listener support is 72% of our budget. The rest comes from federal funding, which is about 18% and being cut back all the time. And the Pacifica foundation kicks in another 10%. So that's how important our listeners are to KPFT. Also, I might also mention that perhaps you tune into KPFT for only a few hours per week, like these few hours. Yeah. So perhaps you only listen to one program like this program. So you might consider yourself to be only a part time listener. Well, did you know that it costs about \$45.55 an hour to put old Jimmy on the air here to run the programming and at KPFT so even part time listeners can have a stake in KPFT so if you listen for only two hours, it costs \$91.10 to run the station just so that you can listen to us banter and carry on like this.
