Now the process involves having the city legal department drop an executive order and having the mayor sign it. And what's interesting to note is that no approval from City Council is needed. And Brown has named to honor people to a special transition team that has been given 90 days to completely evaluate all areas of city government and to come back and report with to the mayor with a detailed report. And that report will share his administrative and legislative agenda for the next two years. And a number of gay and lesbian people are among those 200 people. And Mayor Brown says that he knows because he appointed them. He said that his goal is to make sure that there would be a direct link between him and the gay and lesbian community. Quote, what I've committed to do is to work With the gay and lesbian community and see if we can develop consensus on how to address domestic partner benefits. And this is going to be a first in the city of Houston and I think it is fantastic. Yeah, I
