Andrew Phillip Cunanan the suspect in Tuesday's murder of Italian fashion designer Gianni Versace is Wanted by the FBI for a string of gay related murders in Minnesota, Chicago and New Jersey. Andrew Cunanan is 27 years old, originally from San Diego and travels widely. Some of Cunanan acquaintances have described him as a party boy, with a distinct loud laugh and lots of money just like Roy he is five and a half five feet 10 and a half inches tall, weighs about 195 pounds, not like Roy and has a brown buzzcut. His average boy next door looks allow him to present several different appearances. The FBI is offering a \$10,000 reward for information leading to his arrest. And I think that's actually gone up now.

Q patrol is warning everyone who lives works or socializes in the community to be aware of this person and report any sightings promptly to the FBI. This warning is extended even to persons who do not identify themselves as being gay or bisexual, but who have business social or sexual contacts with the gay community cannot and should be considered dangerous and the FBI warns against taking any direct action. Cardona is intelligent, cunning and described as charming, it is apparent that he uses contact and acquaintances in the gay community to support exaggerated claims of wealth and social status. It is also apparent that he is following news accounts of his crimes and uses these reports to elude authorities. Sure, Canadiens behavior fits the profile of a sociopath which makes him dangerous because he is unlikely to fear the consequences of his actions, and probably has no inhibitions about committing antisocial acts including murder. A sociopath such as Cunanan will present himself with great poise, confidence and serenity, and will show little emotional effect in circumstances that would be embarrassing or physically uncomfortable to a healthy person. These traits allow him to portray himself as wealthy even though he works only a part time jobs. His mother believes that her son earns money as a male prostitute. Andrew Cunanan is suspected of using people in the gay community. He is now also the prime suspect in a series of robberies and murders. If you see this man avoid making contact with him and report his whereabouts properly to the FBI.
