I mean, this is a worldwide for 60 years. Secondly, churches have been asking whether older siblings increase or decrease the odds of homosexuality and later born children. But those studies induction by insurers did not add up to anything and were mostly speculative. Dr. Blanchard's research wouldn't you know, is the first test the hype of the hypothesis using statistical methods on a large homosexuality population. It also is the first to qualify the proportion of homosexual men who are gay because of having older male siblings. And when you're with that, well, Blanchard attributes one in seven phenomenon, known colloquially among sexologist as the Blanchett effect to the excess of the h y antibody in the mother's bloodstream, mounted in response to the h y antigen of previous sons. According to Blanchard, the hypothesis that the h y antigen penetrates the mother's bloodstream during pregnancy with male photo foetus who carries the antigen on the Y chromosome. The mother develops a defensive immunology response to this antigen. The mother's immune response then gains strength with each successive male birth, so that after several sons, the pool of the HLA antibody collects with the maternal bloodstream. Dr. Blanchard arrived at his let me check this this is our big arrived at his one in seven figure by surveying by surveying more than 10,000

homosexual men in England, the Netherlands, Canada and the United States, suspecting that each older brother increases the odds of homosexuality in the later born male babies by a third eye hypothesis advanced by Dr. Bland entered in 1996. He then estimated a number of homosexuality men in this subpopulation with older brothers, and also estimates how many older brothers these men would have. Those statistics estimate, in turn, turned out to match almost identically. The actual self reported numbers of homosexual men, older male siblings in the phenomena that occurred in the one out of seven cases. Quote, interests are absolutely reliable findings. And Dr. Bailey, a leading researcher on homosexuality and a professor of psychology in Chicago, Northwestern University right here in the US of A, there's no way these findings could be superfluous. What makes these findings in specially intriguing said Dr. Blanchard is that one in seven effects surfaces across the discreet homosexual sub population, including homosexual, and everybody else you could think of transgenders and everybody.
