Jim and I were talking about this one night after, after the show is over. Because this is something that's really kind of dear to my heart and very important to me. And I knew something had to be done. And Bruce Marquis has promised me that regardless how this election goes, I can turn to Him. And He will take action. He says any principle that does not take positive reaction to in favor of the student who's been the victim of a hate crime. He's either going to straighten that principle out or they're going to be out. That is a crime and he is not going to tolerate it. For now. Bruce Marquis right now is Chief of Police for HSD. Security Police, he's running for sheriff. So all all of you out there. If you're listening, if you're still listening, or if you know of a kid who's been the recipient of being physically or verbally attacked, for any of these reasons, because they're black, or they're Jewish, or they're gay, or lesbian, or they're Polish or what have you, maybe they're they're handicapped. Okay? Regardless, if they've been the recipient of any of these hate crime physically or verbally, they have to take it to the principal first. And they've got to give the principal a chance to take the appropriate and the correct action. If they do not. You let me know. And I got a buddy who will take care of it, believe me. And on that same vine in that same line. There is now a national hotline that's set up to take calls. After nearly 14 months of planning, and national fundraising and important new nonprofit, all volunteer organization, including services to gay and lesbian used has come into effect. Get your pencil out, because I'm gonna give you another phone number and a toll free call 1888. The GAO N H. Or for those of you who cannot spell, that's 1-888-843-4564. That's 1888843456. For now, this service will provide peer counseling, and information and referrals to gay lesbian and bisexual people, as well as others, you know, concerned with gay related issues.
