I want to give a shout out to Randy down there in Beaumont, Toni way up there and Midway to Allison. Down here in the Montrose along with Mark and Jerry down here in the Montrose and all of our other listeners were out there in the far flung land reaches a radio land. And our top story this week is Steve Holt's, he's in hot water with the state of Texas. Steve Hodes he is with his was a conservative Christian activist, was fined 5000 on a record \$5,000 by the Texas Ethics Commission for violating campaign finance laws. The fine the largest ever imposed by the Commission against the conservative Republicans of Harris County was one of three leveled against a host he Houthi controlled organization. You may remember back in the mid 80s. Steve holds he had his first city council he had what they called a straight slate. And that straight slate got really defeated every one of their candidates were defeated for a city council and tactics, the Texas ethics commission was acting on complaint filed by other local Republican activists. The Commission assessed \$1,400 penalty against the citizens for American restoration and \$500 against the Houston Republican forum. The Texas ethics Commission's stated that the \$5,000 fine is clearly the largest find the commission has imposed. And that was said by Karen linquist whose general counsel for the Ethics Commission. And the complaint said that the mailing that Steve Holsey and his group did, conducted failed to include proper identification of the citizens for the American restoration and its Treasurer, and that the organization failed. Failed to tell the favorite candidates that it was spending money on their behalf. Citizens for the American restoration was fined by the Ethics Commission for that violation. For example, citizens for the American restoration has sent out mailings that appeared to be party sanctioned listings of all candidates in an election, but only includes the candidates backed by hosi. So folks, this is big news from the Texas Ethics

Commission shows you how you have to keep all your T's crossed and your eyes dotted and for any political organization or 5501 C three type organization. They have to there are strict guidelines that have to be followed
