New York City also offered a \$10,000 reward but Mayor Rudolph Giuliani says Carrera doesn't deserve the money because he found Kanaan and by accident. Miami Beach Police have not decided whether to award Carrera the \$45,000 reward they had offered for information leading them to Cunanan.
