And just like in New York, it was a stonewalling riots that began the modern gay rights movement as we know today. It started in New York City. It spread this build create civil unions, gay, gay and lesbian couples, virtually all the benefits of marriage, and it was declared in a critical legislative hurdle and gain final approval in the Vermont State House of Representatives on Thursday night. This is according to a report from the Houston Chronicle. And Governor Howard Dean has said that he will sign it despite the deep Shiism the issue has created among Rivermont. Here's the benefits, like I said, are virtually the same. In providing state recognition for same sex couples who cannot married couples may excuse me, couples may apply for a license from a town clerk and receive a certificate of civil union. And if they split, if they want to divorce, their union must be dissolved in a family court. Now this is one of the some of the wording in that bill. Quote, the state has a strong interest in promoting state stable and lasting families including families based on same sex couplings. Wishing Yes, okay, yeah, Virginia Puzo, who is the interim political director for the National Gay and Lesbian Task Force said that. Vermont has gone further than any other state toward recognizing and sanctioning same sex relationships. This vote represents a significant and historical breakthrough. And folks were if you want to get married or have a civil union, you have to go on up there to Vermont. For right now, eventually it will be all across the country. It will take time folks

Well, Paul chants Dylan, one of the 10 woodland teenagers, convicted in 1991 gay bashing death of Paul Broussard, was released from prison on Friday. Although powerless to contest or halt the release, Nancy Rodriguez, Paul Broussard, his mother, traveled to Huntsville from our Georgia home to be present when Dylan was freed. Rodriguez was quoted as saying, I don't want to talk to him. I don't want to confront the guy. I don't even really want to see him to be quite honest. But I want him to see me. I want him to know I'll be watching him until I die. Dylan now 30 has served about six years of his 20 year sentence and will be released to parole under the state's now defunct mandatory release act. Dylan and nine cohorts all students are former students that makalah High School in The Woodlands drove to the Montrose area on July 4 1991. Looking for homosexuals to harass they bought they bought boards with nails and rocks to throw their victims. The group spotted Paul Broussard and two friends as they were leaving a gay bar and attack them. One of the youth, John Christopher Boyce, stabbed resorted to death, boys received a 45 year sentence for his role in the attack. Dylan got 22 others received 15 year terms. The other five defendants were given probation, but two of them have violated the terms of that probation, and have been sent to prison for 10 to 15 years. Although Dylan's was the second longest term, he's the first to be released due to the old system of that we had for the mandatory release act. And the group that's was started as a result from this incident Q patrol. We're still out and about on the streets. And if you want to help protect your fellow citizens and members of the community, we invite you to come out and join us walk the streets with us.
