let me tell you the net speaking as a woman who is also infected with HIV, I, when I first found out six years ago, there were no organizations in the city of Houston that actually helped women who were infected. And after six years, I really understand how important it is to have a coalition that supplies a you know, that provides a support group supply provides an outreach network, we provide a hotline that if any woman out there finds out she's positive, she knows that she is not alone. And this conference that we put together, we help women and dealing with issues that light such as planning for the future insurance needs. We've got a woman


coming from the Social Security Administration, who is going to talk about Social Security, the processing of herself, security and the disability. We are also looking at alternative approaches to the women who are HIV infected. And we're gonna talk about one of my favorite subjects, women's sexuality and HIV. Hey, just because we have HIV doesn't mean we're not having sex. Okay.

And they're now taking both men and women who've gotten a larger facility, and they're doing both men and women. In fact, this week, I think, if I remember correctly, their first woman will come in. And so it's now they can't handle children, obviously, but this woman doesn't have children. So it's, it's great. So there's a place for an intermediate care for holistic living, to, you know, put them back on the track, getting ready to move back into community. And live again, it's about living with these times not about dying with it, you know,

right, one of the unfortunate things is that women who do find out that there are positive, they do not reach out for the help, and they're afraid to speak out and say, Listen, I'm infected, and I need to get some help. And what they have known, what they have found is that people who live in isolation with this disease, really do not stay as healthy as long as people who speak out about it and who reach out for help the support groups, the women's HIV coalition offers support groups every week. And it's really important that women just keep reaching, where are these HIV support groups that they're offering? Well, we keep the location anonymous, rather than mean, you know, call the line of, you know, 9358530, then you can be referred over to a support group and be a part of a women's group in which women of all ages and color deal with living with HIV. Wow, that's great, what a great.
