And then showed me how like, if you put it on the pulse points on the crook of your elbow, you can still feel your body heat and you can still feel your pulse through these things. So she gave me some information on that and I figured we would just take it from there and make it an ongoing interview. Since she is knowledgeable on women and lesbian safe sex. Okay. Are we getting ready to run that? Okay, let's run it. Here with a friend of mine, we're going to talk about lesbian women's safe sex. Well make sure it's unplugged if it's if it's if it's plugged in kind of liberally Wipe Wipe it down with a washcloth and bleach solution which is one part bleach to 10 parts soapy water.

Condoms make a fabulous dental dam. And if I can kind of explain to you what I'm going to do as long as you can make a dental dam out of a condom, and that's why I put them in. Okay, let's, let's explain what a dental dam is. Okay, a dental dam is dental dam in the in the technical sense, is a square piece of latex and it's usually used by dentists. That's the name dental dam when they're working on your teeth, but it also has a fabulous use as a barrier appropriate to the situation especially with with oral sex, okay. So if you take your condom out of out of its package before you unroll it, if it has a tip on it, and this is another thing when I do lay lesbian at reservoir, okay, that would hold semen. You can also buy condoms without the reservoir tip, which is what I usually do, at least put one of those in with the lesbian with a lesbian pack for the vibrators and those because they're not catching semen, right. I do like if you're going to make dental dams to have the reservoir tip because it makes it easier to take a hold of the condom. You take a hold of the tip with your thumb and your forefinger. I carry around my little pocket knife
