And voting will take place by a mail in ballot to be included in the winter 2000 inside pride newsletter, and during poll voting at the Houston lesbian and gay community center on February 26. The 2000 grand marshals be announced at a press event. On March nine Grand Marshal positions are among the highest honors bestowed by the Houston lesbian and gay community. Nominees should be selected based on their commitment and outstanding contributions made to the community areas of contribution to be considered our social, political health, child welfare, education and business types of contributions to be considered our mentoring, volunteerism, generosity, leadership roles and civic pride. And the types of grand marshals are their CO grand marshals, which are a male and female for the whichever one of them the queer community, right?
