And this bill would also provide aid to small counties prosecuting hate murderers. And we design a prosecutor from the Attorney General's Office as a hate crime director, and require more training for law enforcement officers in investigating and documenting of hate crimes and allow the victims to sue for civil penalties. Then Rodney Ellis said that the proposed wording has already been upheld by the United States Supreme Court. And of course, the proposal is being opposed by the Republican Party.
