The new rules will also require state parties to give priority of consideration to unrepresented groups in the state delegate selection process in order to assist in the achievement of full participation by these groups. And these under represented groups are groups like the gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender community, Hispanic, Asians, blacks, women's groups, and that have traditionally been a big strong bulwark support of the Democratic Party, both in the state of Texas and nationally. And so now, we're getting an official seat at the table. Now, according to Gary Shea, who was a California member of the Democratic National Committee, he said that while the Republican National Committee spent the weekend debating whom to exclude from the Republican Party, the Democratic Party is

building on its record of inclusion and participation, participation. And this is pretty exciting. And we're really looking for I'm really looking forward to seeing what all transpires in the weeks to follow.
