And that it says here that although Jews were the primary victims of the Holocaust in Germany during World War Two non Jews were also targeted by the Nazis. It happened to the Handicapped to Roma and synteny gypsies, to polish intellectuals and priests. And it also happened to homosexuals. in concentration camps throughout Nazi Germany and other countries under Hitler's dictatorship. homosexuals were forced to wear identifying signs just like the Jews, but instead of armbands. These were pink triangles that were worn on their pockets. And in the terrible atmosphere of the camps, homosexuals are treated very cruelly, they were singled out for brutality, not only by concentration, concentration camp guards, but by other inmates as well. And when the long awaited liberation finally came, these victims of Nazi oppression were not released. But were forced instead to serve out the rest of their terms in prison. And excuse me. And now the people from the Holocaust Museum is asking the community for for donations so that they can have a permanent display for the Forgotten victims of the Holocaust, the Forgotten victims being gay people in particular. And in addition to asking for donations, they're also asking for, if anyone

has any actual memorabilia from people who were victims, gay victims of the Holocaust and Nazi Germany to donate them to donate those things as well to the Holocaust Museum.
