Now, let me tell you about 1949. In 1949, if anybody was out of the closet, we don't have their name. That's right. That's what 5454 We got like Frank Cameron, his name and 52 we got we got Harry Hayes name. But in 1949, we didn't have any names. But Lu Hill founded the Pacifica Foundation, he was an unmarried attorney, pacifist, free thinker living in San Francisco. I mean, I mean, these things begin to give an impression on him. Yeah. And he founded the Pacifica Foundation. He plied for the last available am license in the market. They denied him that but they gave him the first available FM license. First FM, and it was the first non commercial radio station in the business. That's specific effect. By the late 50s, you were beginning to hear interviews with people from the magnet chain society. Also about that time somebody gave Pacific foundation WBI in New York. So we were on both coasts. And then KPFT got organized. And then the fourth station in the network was kicked off in Houston. from its very inception, and I was one of the people that helped organize KPFT I was with the station two years before it went on the air. I would later serve as manager. And the situation is that, that the reason we have Pacifica at all, is because gay people believe in free speech more than others, because we have a greater investment in their being free speech media. And from time to time, you will hear other gay and lesbian brokers manufacture their gay and lesbian programs in most major cities in the country. There are gay and lesbian programs on every Pacifica station in the network. Oh, I didn't know absolutely and envisions way out maybe two or three. In addition, you hear Alicia Chappelle, who is the program director of KPFT cute little black lives hands. She is a Heart Radio professional. She really is a thing. I've met her that march on Washington, 79 March in Washington and 87 She did all that she does all that she's a genius at putting together the network things and now she's got the weekly news program, which is a very vital part. Can you imagine what it's like to somebody in Kansas City to have somebody from the gay and lesbian community go out and get enough sponsors to buy 30 minutes at two o'clock in the morning on on Monday morning, which is worse than two o'clock in the morning on Sunday morning.
