Our top story tonight is a A very important court case, that was one out in Vermont and it could have effect here in Texas as well. And in case if those of you who have not been following the news, the Vermont Supreme Court this past week, has ruled that gay couples are entitled to the exact same legal benefits and protection as married couples. However, they did not go so far as to say that gay couples can have same sex marriages. But we are entitled to the same legal benefits and protections. The decision to acknowledge plank now, this is what the court said, this is a quote from the court. The decision to acknowledge plaintiffs as Vermonters who seek nothing more or less than legal protection and security, for their avowed commitment to intimate and lasting human relationship is simply when all said and done a recognition of our common humanity. And I think that that really says a lot right there. Now, the court gave the state legislature a reasonable period of time to either expand marriage to include same sex couples or to an enact a domestic partnership regime that looks and acts like marriage. On the one hand, the court definitely rejected the state's purported reasons for withholding legal sanctions from same sex couples, including the principle worry, which we hear about all the time that doing so would undermine the link between procreation and childbearing. The Vermont court ruled that many opposite sex couples don't get married with any idea toward having children, some never do

and others can't. At the same time, many same sex couples are raising children, and their future is harmed, not helped by withholding legal protection from their parents relationship. And, folks, this is a very significant ruling from the Vermont Supreme Court. That is the court of last resort. In Vermont. There is no appeal after that.

And hopefully this isn't going to end up similar to the Hawaiian Supreme Court ruling, which actually became negated when they said it was unconstitutional to ban gay marriages and gay domestic partnerships, by having the state legislature put out in a state referendum for a constitutional amendment, which made it by doing that kind of circumvented the

ruling. But what the Supreme Court said is that the state legislature has to either change their marriage law or enact a law that protects same sex couples,

which is good to see that and unfortunately, what's going to happen is, if they make something it'll probably be so watered down, that there won't be anything. No, it's something it's something that you're not going to see happen in a year or two, I think if anything is going to come out of it is probably going to be about four years before it gets kicked back to the state supreme court to review the legislative plan. Because whatever plan they put forth, there's going to be a group like the Family Research Center. And organizations along those lines that worked in Hawaii, who would keep any law that's enacted, no matter by what legal means it was done. But we'll try and keep that law off the books and unenforced for several years and tied up in court.
