And we do agree the majority of our incidents that we see in the community is either teenagers coming out from the extreme north, or the extreme southern suburbs of Houston. And from some of the people from the halfway houses that are just north of Fairview, a couple of blocks, that is where the majority of our violent attacks have come as of late.

But what we're what we're just reporting is the fact that we had three people over a week long period, who called into our phone number five to eight safe, and stopped us on the streets that night, and told us that this activity was going on. And we I just thought that something of that magnitude that we seem to have a group of people similar characteristics, who were doing harm in our community, I just thought it'd be a good idea to put that out to everyone who might be listening at that time. And so if someone can felt that I was being offensive in any way, I was not intended, I was just giving a description of what was reported to us.
