Realistically, we know not everyone can do that because of age, job, or frame of mind. That's OK. We're here for you too. So sit back, relax, and enjoy this week's edition of *After Hours*.

[THEME MUSIC]

Hello, Houston and College Station, and welcome to *After Hours*, queer radio with attitude. Today is the February 24th edition, and let me tell you a little something about the music you heard. That was the music of Marcy Rae. You can hear her once a week at the Briar Patch singing.

And those three cuts, the last one, of course, "Desperate Old Guy", we've played that before. Before that was "I Slept With", and the first one was, "Chuck Chuck Bow Puck". And I don't know why it was named that because it certainly-- I don't know. Anyway, it's fun music from Marcy Rae.

And good reason I played that, first of all, because Marcy Rae's a wonderful entertainer and comedienne, and friend of the community. And she's also has a-- what is this-- press release, be there or be square, between brunch and the bars tomorrow, Sunday, February 25th at 3:30 PM.

Join Marcy Rae, and she does go by another name, Sweet Mama Cotton, at Cactus Music, Shepherd, Alabama for an in-store performance. Signing and celebration of her new CD, Marcy Rae live at the Hollywood. Yes, that music was taped live at the Hollywood Hotel down in Galveston with an audience, of as you might guess, Briar Patch denizens.

So, we'll mention that again later in the show. But Cactus Music tomorrow, that's Shepherd, Alabama, 3:30, to see Marcy Rae. And what a fun, wonderful woman she is, too. And more music that you want to hear about is the Queer Music Heritage. JD Doyle's own Queer Music Heritage, which is heard every fourth Monday on Lesbian and Gay Voices.

And they are on this station at 8 to 10 every Monday night. JD's segment will start at 9:00. And this month, he's including special interviews with Matthew Claren and Christy Claxton. Christy, who did a wonderful, wonderful concert last week over at the Sidecar Pub with Daniel Lynch.

TARA: You messed up your first day.

TOMMY: What did you do?

RYAN: Sorry.

TOMMY: OK, we'll do a whole little spiel of introduction to HATCH and stuff. OK, HATCH meets on Fridays and Sundays. It stands for Houston Area Teen Coalition of Homosexuals. I am Tommy, steering committee member, HATCH king.

JUSTIN: I am Justin, steering committee member, HATCH queen.

TOMMY: You go now.

RYAN: Me?

TOMMY: Yeah.

RYAN: I'm Ryan. I just messed up the feedback.

TOMMY: You can move that microphone thingy. So, yeah.

RYAN: All right.

TOMMY: Rock on.

RYAN: I just messed up the feedback. This is my first time here. So, hey.

TOMMY: OK, and those little headphone thingies, they go over your ear.

RYAN: Yeah, but when I put it in there, it messed up the feedback thing, so.

TARA: It made it all-- it made it all--

RYAN: I'll try later

TARA: --screechy.

TOMMY: OK, right. Who are you?

TARA: Yes, who am I?

TOMMY: Why are you in the booth?

JUSTIN: Did I invite you?

TARA: I got lost.

JUSTIN: Do I know you?

TARA: No.

TOMMY: Do I know you?

JUSTIN: Turn to this.

TOMMY: Hey, why are you going to steal that stuff from me?

RYAN: I told you I was going to jack it.

TOMMY: Oh.

TARA: OK. Anyways, I'm Tara.

TOMMY: That's enough said.

RYAN: Nice to meet you.

TOMMY: OK, and on a sad note, we don't have Gabrielle here. She's in Corpus Christi, right?

JUSTIN: Yes, Corpus.

TOMMY: And she is doing a seminar, and the topic was really funny. I forgot what the name was. Do the name? OK, well, we have a new facilitator guy here.

TARA: Ti-do-do.

RYAN: Yeah.

TOMMY: To keep us all happy and stuff. And see that microphone right there?

BRENDAN: Yeah.

TOMMY: That would go to you.

BRENDAN: Oh, OK. Like this?

TOMMY: Yes. [INAUDIBLE]

BRENDAN: OK, my name is Brendan, and I'm--

TOMMY: Not so far out, though.

BRENDAN: --I'm one of the guy who helps.

TOMMY: Backup, backup.

BRENDAN: Oh, sorry. How about that?

TOMMY: Very great.

BRENDAN: All right, good.

TOMMY: OK, say your name again.

BRENDAN: Brendan.

TOMMY: Brendan. All right. We like all our facilitators and stuff. And guess who else we have in here today now. Very happy to see him.

JUSTIN: And happy to be here--

TOMMY: Who?

JUSTIN: --with my guys.

TOMMY: Who are you?

JUSTIN: David.

TOMMY: All right.

TARA: Yup.

TOMMY: We missed him. I saw him on that magazine thing today, and it really freaked me out to see him again.

TARA: What magazine thing? [INAUDIBLE]

TOMMY: Name the magazine.

BRENDAN: The Eclipse.

TOMMY: Right. [INAUDIBLE] Huh?

RYAN: I'm here on official capacity. I'm just here to--

HOST 1: You just here to--

RYAN: --to visit.

TOMMY: --watch me?

RYAN: Yeah.

TOMMY: And my beauty?

RYAN: Yah.

TOMMY: Yah.

JUSTIN: OK, question number one, what is the hair color of the month?

TOMMY: Of me?

JUSTIN: Yeah!

TOMMY: Oh, OK. Well, this is kind of a funny story. I had a mohawk, but my mommy didn't like it. So--

JUSTIN: Oh, quelle surprise.

TOMMY: So now I have short hair. And I tried to diet pink because my mom bought me hot pink hair dye. I don't know--

TARA: Tell me did you remember to bleach your hair first?

TOMMY: The whole thing was, I didn't have enough hair to dye in the first place that I just died by scalp. So, right now it's like natural brown color.

BRENDAN: With a pink scalp.

TOMMY: It's not pink anymore, is it?

JUSTIN: Well, I think it is.

TOMMY: I did it like three weeks ago. I had to work at the Olive Garden like the next day. Yeah.

TARA: I thought you quit that job like three times.

DAVID: He did.

TOMMY: I've quit there like eight times. I don't know why they keep hiring me back. And then they called me today at the garage sale. It was pretty great. OK.

JIMMY: Yes, tell us about the garage sale!

TOMMY: Well, I was getting there. Calm down.

TARA: Why is there a random voice?

TOMMY: We love Jimmy.

TARA: OK, God. We will love.

[LAUGHTER]

JIMMY: Tell them of the garage sale so they will come.

TOMMY: Along with several donation cans spread throughout the Montrose area, we are having a garage sale today-- which you all missed-- and tomorrow from 9 o'clock to 2 o'clock.

TARA: Where?

TOMMY: At the Gay and Lesbian Community Center. It's not outside go inside.

JUSTIN: It's on Hawthorne.

TOMMY: Yeah, on Hawthorne and Stanford.

JIMMY: Yep.

JUSTIN: Go team.

JIMMY: Go team Tommy.

TOMMY: All right, Jimmy. All right, yeah. Lots of stuff going on with HATCH. Recently, I did a-- I don't know what to call it. It's a public outreach thing with HATCH. It was me and Carol and Freddy. And we went to the Texas Children's Hospital, and we talked to the doctors and stuff there. And we educated them on how to approach gay issues if approached with them or something, yeah. It was pretty interesting. We had fun. I had fun. All right. Y'all are so untalkative now.

TARA: Da-ta-ta.

TOMMY: Hello? Thank you. OK.

JUSTIN: You're welcome.

TOMMY: Today, we're doing something kind of a spinoff off of VH1.

[INTERPOSING VOICES]

TOMMY: If anybody's ever seen the list, we're doing that, only gay style, very gay style.

TARA: No.

TOMMY: Basically how we do everything. Everything gay style.

JUSTIN: We know that.

TOMMY: OK Basically, everybody in the booth and me and Justin--

JUSTIN: Justin and I.

TOMMY: Shut the hell up. We will come up with either like three gay role models, icons, fag hags, whatever, that we find-- that we think-- should be the number one. And after that, we will scratch them off, one [INAUDIBLE] going round about in a circle. Is that OK with everybody?

TARA: What?

JUSTIN: It is.

TOMMY: Simple-minded Tara didn't understand. I.

TARA: Was drawn to pretty flower.

[LAUGHTER]

JUSTIN: Well, a flower.

TOMMY: And she tried to show everybody the flower.

JUSTIN: This is radio, dear.

BRENDAN: So are we talking gay icon or gay role model or both or?

TOMMY: If you--

JUSTIN: All of the above.

TOMMY: --think that they fit in the gay area of anything, then you can put them on this list. Good job for that. Rock on? Rock on. So, first Justin. Who do you think-- name three people who you think should be out in this list and then give reasons why.

JUSTIN: Let me see there.

TOMMY: I actually told y'all to think about this earlier.

JUSTIN: I have to have reasons and stuff?

TOMMY: Well, duh.

JUSTIN: That kind of sucks. I just want to randomly name people.

TOMMY: Well, just randomly named people. You're good at that.

JUSTIN: OK.

TARA: And randomly make up reasons.

TOMMY: Yeah, go ahead.

JUSTIN: OK, Miss Judy Garland for her flawless hair and makeup, Big Gay Al for his legible animated personality, and Barbra Streisand because I like her nose and stuff. There you go. I don't know.

TOMMY: How about because she's got a cute gay son?

JUSTIN: She does?

JIMMY: With a really nice nose?

JUSTIN: Does he have a nice nose, Jimmy?

TARA: Big nose big--

JIMMY: Yeah. Oh.

JUSTIN: And you know what they say about people with big noses.

TOMMY: What does that mean about Barbara having a big nose?

TARA: Yeah.

JUSTIN: Never mind, no.

TOMMY: OK, on to you now.

JIMMY: She doesn't have one of those, but she probably has two of the other.

TOMMY: Mm.

JUSTIN: Yeah.

TOMMY: Two big noses?

JUSTIN: Goodness.

TOMMY: That was wrong.

TARA: Yes, yes, that.

TOMMY: Oh, you know what I forgot to do?

JUSTIN: Really big noses?

JIMMY: What?

TOMMY: I forgot to say the phone numbers.

JUSTIN: Phone numbers!

TOMMY: I forgot phone numbers y'all.

TARA: He forgot the damn phone numbers.

JIMMY: The horror.

TOMMY: I know. OK, the number if you want to get a hold of HATCH, you should call the HATCH phone line and stuff. Thank you for fixing my microphone. That number to that would be 713-942-7002. And then you will talk to some lovely person like Justin.

JIMMY: What If they want to call [INAUDIBLE]?

TOMMY: Huh? I was about to get to that, too.

JUSTIN: Cool being a beast.

TOMMY: I know. What's up with-- never mind. OK, and if you think anybody should be on this list, call in. We'd like to hear, reasons why and everything. The number would be 713-JAM-KPFT, J-A-M KPFT.

JUSTIN: Or what numbers?

TOMMY: The numbers are--

TARA: 713-526-5738.

TOMMY: Oh, wow. Whoa, it's all posted for me now.

JUSTIN: Oh, it comes across the screen [INAUDIBLE].

TOMMY: It used to come up there. Not that that one ever worked or something. But OK. Yeah, now we go to Brendan.

JUSTIN: It's still hard to go up there.

BRENDAN: Wow, this is a hard decision. My first guy on the list, I guess, would be Alexander the Great. He conquered most of the known world and whose influence has been felt to this very day. Most of modern-- or a lot of modern civilization has been based upon what he spread across the world. That'd be my first choice. Second choice would be Harvey Milk, I guess. He was the mayor-- or not the mayor-- please excuse me. A city council member. I forget what they called it in San Francisco. But--

JUSTIN: Supervisor.

BRENDAN: Supervisor, who, of course, was killed along with the mayor at the time, who had a big influence, and I think influenced a lot of people, gay people. And gosh, the third choice, Ricky Martin because he's just so damn cute.

TARA: Hello.

BRENDAN: Those are my choices.

TOMMY: And let us remind you all, cuteness is a factor.

BRENDAN: OK.

TOMMY: Tara?

TARA: Ah--

TOMMY: 10 bucks says she goes along with the fag hag theme.

TARA: Bette Midler?

JUSTIN: Yah.

TOMMY: Why?

TARA: Because I love her, and I think she's great.

JUSTIN: Shut up.

TOMMY: [INAUDIBLE]. I'm all up for Bette Midler but--

TARA: OK, he grew up--

TOMMY: His reasons were better than yours.

TARA: What were your reasons?

JUSTIN: OK, number two. What's your number two?

TARA: Can they be characters from shows?

BRENDAN: Well, he's got Big Al on there.

TOMMY: Well, OK.

BRENDAN: Yeah, [INAUDIBLE] good to go.

TARA: I'm going with Grace, from Will and Grace. Obviously, because she's a great hag, and [INAUDIBLE].

JUSTIN: Will's a great fag.

TARA: [INAUDIBLE]

TOMMY: Who?

TARA: And, oh. And I'm going with Jack because I love Just Jack.

TOMMY: Jack?

TARA: Uh-huh.

TOMMY: So your choices are Bette Midler, Grace and Jack.

TARA: Yes.

TOMMY: From Will and Grace.

TARA: Uh-huh.

TOMMY: All right, got to write this down so I can remember.

TARA: I'm writing it down. I've got a whole list.

TOMMY: That's good because I was going to tell you to do that. I forgot, Grace from--

TARA: No, I've already got it. You don't have to write it down.

TOMMY: Well, I have to write it down for me. OK.

TARA: Shut up. I got it.

TOMMY: OK, David voted for Madonna.

TARA: Who's David?

JUSTIN: David who?

TOMMY: I'm thinking it's David from HATCH.

JIMMY: Yeah, it is.

TOMMY: Yes, it is. Right away, we've got a yes for David from HATCH. Thank you David for actually listening or something.

TARA: He's listening?

TOMMY: Yeah.

TARA: He's-- at past nine?

TOMMY: That's what I was thinking. Whoa.

TARA: So, none of us are going to be talked to when we get back from this.

TOMMY: What do you mean?

TARA: Because he'd be mad at us for saying that.

TOMMY: Oh, darn. But he doesn't do anything. David isn't in yet.

JUSTIN: How am I going to live out that three seconds of being upset?

TOMMY: Oh, no.

JIMMY: OK.

TOMMY: I love you, David. [INAUDIBLE]. OK, how about you?

RYAN: It's on me? Number one, I think Bjork. There's lots of little indie boys running around who are in love with Bjork so I think she's cool.

TOMMY: OK.

RYAN: Who else?

JUSTIN: Socrates.

RYAN: My goodness.

JUSTIN: Socrates. [INAUDIBLE]

RYAN: I need to do this for my friend, Nathan, even though he can't hear me. But I'm going to say Jude Law.

TOMMY: Who's that?

TARA: Oh!

JUSTIN: Who's that?

TOMMY: Yeah.

TARA: He was in *The Talented Mr Ripley*.

TOMMY: Right.

TARA: He would-- tsk.

TOMMY: Do uncultured swine come on [INAUDIBLE]?

JUSTIN: DAVID: You just call me that? You're on that side of the booth.

TOMMY: OK, Jude Law. [INAUDIBLE].

TARA: Go you.

RYAN: Just because.

TOMMY: Oh, shut the hell up.

RYAN: Just because.

JUSTIN: He's so damn cute?

RYAN: Yeah, I think so.

TARA: He's got a nice [? hiney ?].

RYAN: Yeah, he doesn't really do it for me in all the ways. But I'm going to go and put him anyway because he's just great.

TOMMY: Two out of three is fine.

RYAN: Two out of three is fine. Goodness gracious. Well, I don't know.

JUSTIN: He's like about to--

TOMMY: OK, this isn't *Jeopardy*. Don't take all the [INAUDIBLE].

RYAN: I'm sorry. I'm sorry. I got to come up with something else. I wasn't privy to this list before, so I have to come up with them on the spot.

JUSTIN: Did you say privy?

TARA: (HUMMING) Do, do, do, do.

JUSTIN: Did you just say bathroom?

RYAN: I'm still drawing a blank on people.

TARA: (HUMMING) Do, do, do, do.

RYAN: Holy jeez.

TOMMY: There are few meanings for the word privy, darling.

TARA: Yeah, but I'd rather hold this one.

TOMMY: OK, what is the definition of privy?

JUSTIN: Bathroom.

TARA: Here.

TOMMY: Bathroom?

JUSTIN: Yeah.

TOMMY: I have knowledge of--

RYAN: Ellen, Ellen, Ellen.

TOMMY: Ellen? Is that your--

RYAN: Yes, Ellen. Yes, that would be my fave one.

TOMMY: El-- en. OK.

RYAN: Thank you.

TARA: You're welcome.

JUSTIN: It's all how we say.

TOMMY: OK.

TARA: See, what you don't know is I have an entire list of people over here.

TOMMY: Whoa! Good for you.

JUSTIN: Wow.

TOMMY: Bring some of that list over here.

TARA: OK.

TOMMY: No, I pretty much who I'm thinking of. First of all, I'm going to choose Greg Louganis.

BRENDAN: Oh, good choice.

TOMMY: I love Greg Louganis.

BRENDAN: Good choice.

TOMMY: Like, I love him a lot. He's very, very, very, very, very, very, very sexy.

TARA: Who is he?

TOMMY: Holy jeez.

BRENDAN: Who is Greg Louganis?

TARA: Yes.

BRENDAN: Oh, God.

TOMMY: OK, and you all were calling me uncultured swine? Who are you?

RYAN: She said it. I know who he is.

TOMMY: OK, Greg Louganis is like the best Olympic diver in the game. Like--

RYAN: Ever.

TOMMY: --ever.

RYAN: Tommy's a diver, so.

BRENDAN: Four gold medals, I believe.

TOMMY: Yeah, he's very, very [? corny ?].

BRENDAN: Platform and springboard.

TOMMY: He hit his head on the springboard diving board once--

TARA: Oh, that was him?

TOMMY: --while--

TARA: OK.

TOMMY: --being infected with the HIV virus, didn't tell anybody. It didn't really matter. There's chlorine in the pool, but--

TARA: I just didn't know his name.

JUSTIN: Nobody would get unless he was bleeding profusely.

TOMMY: He was in the gay games. I forget what year, but he was in there.

TARA: OK, I got to point.

TOMMY: It's OK. I need--

BRENDAN: And spokesman for Speedo?

TOMMY: Yes. He also was in Playgirl.

BRENDAN: Mm-hmm. OK, I remember that.

TOMMY: I have all those pictures. Aw.

RYAN: Yes.

TOMMY: They're all very good. And yeah, he's just all around a great guy, published author. Just got what?

JIMMY: My attention.

TOMMY: Oh.

JIMMY: He was in Playgirl?

TOMMY: Yes.

JIMMY: Like naked?

TOMMY: No.

RYAN: No, completely clothed--

TOMMY: He was fully--

RYAN: --in formal wear.

TOMMY: --fully clothed. Including the socks.

BRENDAN: I don't think they were that revealing. The photos weren't that revealing though.

RYAN: They don't have to be.

BRENDAN: Oh, that's true. They don't.

TOMMY: I think he had a towel over his like--

BRENDAN: Yeah.

TOMMY: Yeah.

BRENDAN: His area.

TOMMY: You saw his--

BRENDAN: His member.

JUSTIN: --his butt?

TOMMY: I don't know. I don't think you see his member.

BRENDAN: No, you don't. Not that I would know.

[LAUGHS]

JUSTIN: He has like 18 copies in his house. Look at him.

TOMMY: Pervert.

BRENDAN: Yeah, number two.

RYAN: Number two.

TOMMY: Yeah, I'm going there.

RYAN: Go there now.

TOMMY: Now?

BRENDAN: Go there now.

TOMMY: All impatient.

TARA: Dang, dang, dang.

TOMMY: I will put Gary Van Ooteghem.

[APPLAUSE]

I can't spell his name.

RYAN: Very good. Very good. Very good.

TARA: What was the last name?

BRENDAN: The stupid people in the booth would like to know who that is. That's me, too. Sorry.

TOMMY: You want to help me?

RYAN: Yes. [INAUDIBLE]

TOMMY: Yeah, he just recently passed away this year.

RYAN: He was the founder of the Houston Gay and Lesbian Political Caucus.

JUSTIN: Oh, wow.

RYAN: He was a founder of the Log Cabin Republicans.

TOMMY: I like that one.

RYAN: He also worked with PFLAG to set up the scholarship fund for students.

TARA: Wow. [INAUDIBLE]

RYAN: He got his first notoriety. He was working for the city and came out of the closet back in the '70s, and he was promptly fired. He sued, and I believe he lost that suit.

TOMMY: Yeah, right.

RYAN: But he has always been in the forefront of gay politics here in Houston.

TOMMY: OK.

RYAN: He was also I believe the only Texan who was listed in the most important people who died in 2000 by Out magazine. OK, and my third choice is Mayor Lee Brown.

JUSTIN: Wow.

TOMMY: He's the only Texas mayor that's been in a pride parade. He was in it this year. Well, last year, last pride parade. Very supportive for gay rights, he's all around a very good guy. Everybody understand that?

JUSTIN: Yeah.

TOMMY: OK. Now, we are going into a section two.

JUSTIN: Do we get to cross people off?

TOMMY: Yes.

JUSTIN: All right.

TOMMY: See, this is the point that you're supposed to try to make people mad, and stuff, and yeah. So y'all have a list of what everybody chose. Does anybody else want to add anybody on the list? The list? Y'all doing OK? How about you?

RYAN: I think that you've got some of the ones I've already-- I would certainly put Harvey Milk. I would certainly put Mr Van-- I can't pronounce his last name.

TOMMY: Ooteghem.

RYAN: Ooteghem, yeah. I should be able to pronounce these things. I'm from New York. Ooteghem. And--

TOMMY: Don't kick me you fool.

RYAN: Probably at this point, I know this is controversial, especially after the Grammy Awards. But Elton John for at least an attempt at bridging some gaps between people who mouth off hateful things and the gay community. I know he's been slammed left and right because of what he did. But in hindsight, I think it wasn't a particularly bad thing to do.

TOMMY: OK, before we go into this, I'm going to read off who we have, make sure everybody's got the same thing going on. Justin has chosen Judy Garland, Big Gay Al, Barbra Streisand. Do you have that Justin wrote that?

TARA: Yes.

TOMMY: OK, good. Just making sure.

JUSTIN: Good Lord.

TOMMY: Calm down.

TARA: I know how to write.

TOMMY: Ugh! You might be dyslexic.

JUSTIN: Lestexic.

TOMMY: Yes.

TARA: Well, I'm not.

TOMMY: Good. Brendan has chosen Alexander the Great, Harvey Milk and Ricky Martin. Tara, Bette Midler, Grace from *Grace Under Fire*.

TARA: What?

TOMMY: I have no idea where I got that. *Will & Grace*, I'm sorry.

JUSTIN: OK, that one's going off the list. You just got to tell me off the list.

TOMMY: Shut the hell up.

TARA: Tommy automatically loses. He's stupid.

TOMMY: OK, Grace from what?

JUSTIN: Grace Lake.

TOMMY: Grace Lake.

JUSTIN: From *Will & Grace*.

TARA: It's from *Will & Grace*.

TOMMY: Huh?

TARA: It's like three words Tommy, *Will & Grace*.

TOMMY: That's what I said!

TARA: You said *Grace Under Fire*.

TOMMY: Yeah, but I wasn't meaning that and I--

TOMMY: Oh, Ricky Martin!

JUSTIN: He refuses to come out of the closet, I'm sorry. Like, national TV, he's-- yeah, so.

TARA: He all beat around the question. He's like, oh, I can't say.

JUSTIN: Yeah, [INAUDIBLE] to do is for Ricky Martin.

TOMMY: So no She Bangs. It should be He Bangs.

JUSTIN: Yeah. Sorry.

TOMMY: OK. Next up, Brendan.

BRENDAN: OK. Grace, I mean, she's a fictional character on TV. Please, she's not even gay. Off the list.

TARA: She's a good hag.

TOMMY: No, she plays a good hag.

BRENDAN: Sorry.

JUSTIN: Tara's role model's dead. Poor Tara.

TOMMY: OK, Tara.

TARA: I'd have to go with Justin's Big Gay Al.

TOMMY: Oh, I like the girl.

TARA: Too bad it's a fictional cartoon character.

BRENDAN: And it's a cartoon character. And he's not--

JUSTIN: I thought it was a good idea.

TARA: Well, you're stupid.

JUSTIN: Oh, shut the hell up.

BRENDAN: [INAUDIBLE] was too, I mean.
[INTERPOSING VOICES]

BRENDAN: --right down to it.

TARA: Do you wouldn't bring it over here?

JUSTIN: I'm always a [INAUDIBLE].

TARA: Let's go.

RYAN: That's like kind of cool, though.

TOMMY: Just because she looks fabulous.

RYAN: [? Mimi Bobeck ?]

TOMMY: Oh, [INAUDIBLE]. She's a thing on [INAUDIBLE].

TARA: OK, who are you crossing off?

RYAN: Yeah, I'm just going to-- You know what? I'm going to take off here Greg Louganis.

TOMMY: No.

RYAN: I'm so-- even this even if this will like spawn a Jude Law lash back [INAUDIBLE] but--

TOMMY: Holy jeez. That was like my favorite.

RYAN: I know it was your favorite. But--

TOMMY: Jude Law is not even gay, and you're crossing out Greg Louganis?

RYAN: Well, Jude Law was mime. I can't cross off that.

TOMMY: You can. I won't get mad if you-- oh, OK.

TARA: Go, Tommy.

BRENDAN: Come on, Tommy.

TOMMY: I'm taking off Bjork.

RYAN: Oh!

TOMMY: I think she is freaking ugly. I am sorry. Her music is not that great.

RYAN: No!

TARA: No, it's not.

RYAN: Oh, come on. It's the smart man [INAUDIBLE].

TARA: It's the sma-- no.

TOMMY: Yes.

TARA: No.

TOMMY: Yes.

RYAN: David wants to go on air.

TOMMY: If you want him--

RYAN: To call.

TOMMY: --to call, tell him to call back in. So David, let's take a vote. Should David call back in?

JUSTIN: All in favor say aye.

TOMMY: Aye.

RYAN: What?

JUSTIN: All the oppose?

TOMMY: OK. You got--

JUSTIN: That's two against David.

TOMMY: It's two. I don't even care.

JUSTIN: Two.

[LAUGHS]

TARA: OK, so David is going online.

TOMMY: David, you call back now. Oh, wait a minute, is he in here? Oh, not yet.

JUSTIN: No, but we have him on speed dial. Oh, he called twice in a row. That's a little bit obsessive.

TOMMY: Well, he's not over here yet. So come down. Justin, we're up to you again.

JUSTIN: Oh, OK. Let me see that little paper here.

TOMMY: Oh, keep going.

JUSTIN: Did I kick David off?

TOMMY: Yeah, till we get down to like--

JUSTIN: What are we going down to?

TARA: Hey.

TOMMY: We're going to get to the number one.

TARA: [? Coming in ?] seconds. Oh.

TOMMY: What?

TARA: You have callers.

TOMMY: Right. But Jimmy says hold up, and that's why we are holding up.

JUSTIN: I would like to point out that Tommy spelt Bette wrong and Bette Midler.

TARA: Tommy!

RYAN: Tommy can't spell anything.

TARA: You are going--

TOMMY: Shut the hell up.

RYAN: Cross Tommy off the list.

BRENDAN: Yeah, cross him off the list.

TOMMY: No!

JUSTIN: OK, I'm taking--

JIMMY: Ready? Are you ready for David?

TOMMY: Yeah.

JUSTIN: OK.

TOMMY: Yes, David?

JUSTIN: What do you want?

TOMMY: Hi.

DAVID (ON PHONE): Oh, crossed Madonna off the list. Perfect.

TARA: We didn't cross Madonna off.

DAVID (ON PHONE): Oh, these people.

RYAN: I don't have any.

TOMMY: I take it y'all can't hear David.

RYAN: No.

JUSTIN: I can't. I don't have those headphone things.

TOMMY: Yeah, that's because you suck.

TARA: I can. I have headphone things.

TOMMY: Me and Tara can. That's all that matters, and my microphone thing is weird.

TARA: OK.

TOMMY: All right.

TARA: Keep talking, David.

DAVID (ON PHONE): Man, I should have been there, defend myself and my honor.

TOMMY: Defend yourself?

TARA: Should've, would've--

TOMMY: You don't have honor.

TARA: --didn't. Goodbye.

DAVID (ON PHONE): Whatever, Tara.

TOMMY: Also, there's a person on line one, who just has the question of how can gay men sit here and criticize the beauty of a woman? He thinks Bjork is a beautiful woman.

RYAN: Oh, heck, yeah. Dude, whoever you are, I love you.

TARA: How [? annoying ?].

TOMMY: First of all, yeah, we got a bisexual here.

RYAN: I could be bisexual.

TOMMY: He could be.

RYAN: Like, I could-- maybe.

TARA: Ryan!

RYAN: Look--

TOMMY: Does that mean you are?

RYAN: Maybe. I'm not going to disclose that all the way.

BRENDAN: Bjork is the bomb.

TOMMY: No, she's not.

JUSTIN: Yes, she is.

TOMMY: Shut the hell up.

JUSTIN: So anyway, I'm ready to kick Jack off.

[LAUGHTER]

RYAN: Good. That was who I was going to vote for next.

DAVID (ON PHONE): You're waiting for that word, too, Justin.

TOMMY: OK, David, I'm going to let you vote once.

JUSTIN: How do I disconnect David?

[LAUGHTER]

DAVID (ON PHONE): Who is this Ryan character?

TARA: He says who is this Ryan character.

RYAN: Oh, I'm sorry.

TOMMY: He's--

RYAN: Oh hey, what's up? What's up with you?

TOMMY: --a guy that I know that you'd--

TARA: He was there to witness my brutal nose bleeding.

DAVID (ON PHONE): Is that dog show?

RYAN: What did he say?

TOMMY: He asked if you were a dog show.

RYAN: Yeah, it is. What's up, man?

DAVID (ON PHONE): Oh, and again, I'm-- anyway, I want to kick off somebody, and I have a good reason for it.

TOMMY: OK.

DAVID (ON PHONE): I want to kick off Elton John because having him up there--

TARA: Elton John.

TOMMY: Elton John is getting kicked off?

DAVID (ON PHONE): Yeah. Having him up there with Eminem, kind of shows all the people watching it that if Elton John is super gay guy, is OK with Eminem, then all gay people must be OK.
