She sponsored legislation requiring that custody disputes be settled in the best interest of a child that barred discrimination on race, religion, or sexual orientation. She introduced the first bill to allow marriage without regard to sexual orientation. She co sponsored and passed legislation to address and the escalating pattern of gay targeted racial and Anacin minik violence in Texas. That's the Paul Broussard bill if I can call it that. She spoke out at city hall right after the vicious murder of Paul Broussard, recommending that the police department include a hiring policy that allowed people regardless of sexual orientation. She as the chair of the Appropriations Committee, on AIDS, the Subcommittee on AIDS in 1989, she successfully led the effort to more than quadruple funding for aid services from 3.4 to \$18.4 million. And this past session, Deborah successfully lobbied colleagues on appropriations to keep zero budgeting of aid services bottled up in committee. She the list just goes on and on.

He had a an officer that was under his jurisdiction that he assigned to work the gay pride parade. The officer said, Oh, no, no, no. Made some derogatory statements, that officers no longer with Jack's office and he doesn't want those type of people in his office. And that's just the kind of man Jack is Jack says I will be here for equal protection under the law. I've

heard this so many times out of this man's mouth, equal protection under the law for every citizen, no matter who you are, no matter what your race, your religion, your sexual orientation. My men are there men and women are there for
