And you're Laramie, Wyoming, in 1998, sparked outrage and activism by gay rights groups across the country. They've discovered some new facts related to the case they wanted to explore that said ABC News spokesman Jeffrey Schneider of the 2020 report that will be airing on November 26. The segment will explore Laramie underground world of meth and whether or not Shepard knew his killers. He thinks that the McGuigan crystal meth are two possibilities that they're exploring. So basically, you know, one of the shepherds friends that does it, does it make Aaron McKinney and Russell Henderson less guilty of the crime they committed? No, no, absolutely not.
