The dedication, which will take place on Veterans Day Saturday, November 11, at the National Memorial Cemetery in Phoenix represents a critical turning point in honor honoring gays and lesbian veterans according to the group. This memorial pays tribute to those who have served their country and and will be willing to sacrifice everything, said Willie strong, a spokesperson for the Arizona group. It is not only for those men and women who gave their lives, but also those who sacrificed their career, their honor and their dignity to serve in the military. Strong denotes three specific incidents involving gay and lesbian servicemembers in recent years. The death of two men who were killed when

their barracks were bombed in Beirut, the murder of Sailor Allen Schindler in Japan and the murder in July 1999, a private first cleric, Private First Class PFC Barry WinCo, a soldier at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, who incidentally that Commandant lost his he lost his assignment there who was attacked and killed by fellow servicemembers who thought he was gay. This memorial is for them and those who have served for a number of reasons. Some come from a long line of service members and feel drawn by family honor. Some have entered the military to escape poverty. This memorial honors all of them.
