But people in the Montrose area and people interested in gay and lesbian rights should vote for him. The Houston gay lesbian Political Caucus has endorsed his opponent. So why card? Well, because they said for two reasons. Number one, they didn't know who Mike Anderson was, which I find less than credible. I mean, how the hell do we have people running the political organization for the gay and lesbian community in Houston who do not even know who the prosecutor was and in The Woodlands 10 case, because his name is in print constantly. And number two, they said, Well, he didn't come screen business and the other guy did. Well, any Republican who comes screened with gay and lesbian police Liberal caucus is gonna get Stephen Haute seen his merry band of religious not that bad and pissing on their leg and trying to politically kill them. So we are supposed to be sophisticated enough to figure these things out. But there is no mechanism currently in the caucus to do that. I have some concerns about the decision making process, the ability to follow rules over there. And I'm saying that I'm one of the founders of the organization. Matter of fact, that was the last founder, the organization still active in the organization until I left sometime last year, but okay, but my point is that you must go vote. And generally speaking, the safest thing you can do as a voter is to vote a straight Democratic ticket. However, however, when you go back, you can go back to the 2/62 and vote Republican in that race. And you can listen to the folks over at the log cabin and see if they have any other recommendations. But my recommendation is be sure and at least express some form of gratitude to Mike Anderson, running for the 2/62 because he deserves it. The other thing I want to talk about today, Pedro, Oregon thing, ah, the Pedro, Oregon, there will be another demonstration tomorrow afternoon at 2pm. Yes, and it will be at the intersection of Bel Air. And hillcroft. Wow, there is That's right around the corner from where he was actually shot. Oh, okay. And so this demonstration is going to focus on the geography over there in that neck of the woods, beginning at 2pm. We're going to have few speeches at the intersection and we're going to walk over to the apartments where the incident happened. And Johnny Holmes has been in newspapers saying well, you don't understand because you don't know the facts or

if you knew the facts, then you wouldn't be in favor of these officers being exonerated. Wait a minute. I have been on this picket line for 32 years. I was on this picket line when Kevin McCoy blue Fred pyres. Secretary office secretary of the caucus brains out in 1980. I was on this picket line when they had the cop riot that pumped 1000s of rounds of ammunition into a dormitory at Texas Southern University over the closure of Wheeler Street. We have been I mean, how many names Joe compass Carthoris, who over at the midnight sun, which is now the Q tips or something I forget the name of the plates but whatever it is, Joe compass Torres used to play pool there and he stumbled home drunk and a bunch of cops killed him that night, and never has a Harris County grand jury under the tutelage of Harris County District Attorney's Office found a single cop that did anything wrong, either. Delaney John Gilliam, how many names can we name a people that were shot in the back by police bullets, and never has gay people, black people, brown people, white people, poor people. Remember, Randall Webster and the throwdown gun. And the grand jury said no cop did anything wrong right over and over again. We've depended upon the federal authorities to come in and prosecute these cases when they should have been taken care of by state authorities before the Feds got here. So I'm sorry, Mr. Holmes, we know more than we can stand. We know so much it makes us sick. And the fact of the matter is, you're not watching the misbehavior of Houston police officers nor were any of your predecessors. It's time for us to do something about that. A lot of gay people showed up at vote for a vote. This is a different issue. There's more direct politics. So I mean, Johnny Holmes doesn't have an opponent is not even running in this race. We'll get him into yours. But the thing about it is, is that there were a lot of gay men and lesbians that showed up down for the Oregon demonstration because of sharp memories of what police have done to gay people over the years. Yes, and I want to invite the actors audience to vote tomorrow afternoon, join us over at Bel Air and hillcroft at 2pm and join you will be welcomed there by as strange of people as aquatennial legs. And and other people have understood that gay men and lesbians are part of the coalition dealing with the police issue. And we're going to continue to be that part of the coalition.
