guard I see from the outside window is holding this magazine up to a couple of people showing to a couple of people who are sitting on the bench, excuse me, pointing at the different words saying I can see his lips saying the different words and there he's laughing. And so I come in through the door. And here he's making, you know, some negative comments and laughing about you know, queer and faggot and whatever. And I thought well, where in the world did he get this? Because I can't imagine Randles carries out smile. No, absolutely not. So I stop and I asked him. Do y'all carry that magazine here?
