And on Monday, it was lobbying day in Austin to pressure our legislators to pass a hate crimes bill. Now 1000s were in attendance as well as ABC, CBS, NBC and CNN TV news teams. Neither are neither our local news, TV news stations, nor the Chronicle had any coverage whatsoever of

this important event. What does that tell you bigger now, it is my firm conviction that there is no more honorable, just righteous or patriotic cause that can actively work to stop the hate. And not only get an anti hate crime bill passed, but to put an end to discrimination against gays and lesbians in the workplace. Now, I contacted KTRK Kaicho, you KPRC, KR IV and Ken WSS, channel 51. And they all told me that they did not know anything about the rally, nor about the schedule lobby. Now, I contacted all these newsrooms by 8am. Monday morning. And expected, I expected some sort of a catch up news story about the lobbying day at on the 5pm or the 6pm newscast. Nothing at all, not even on the 10pm newscast. And they knew because I told them, they can't say that they didn't know because I told them and they were able to get in touch with their affiliates up there in us in Austin. Now I'm angry and I'm very angry about this blackout of such an honorable cause. And I've cancelled my subscription to the Houston Chronicle. Now I want to call upon our leaders here in the community to call the local media into account. And not only the media, and not allow the media to say that we didn't have a large enough turnout. Because this issue is not about numbers. It is about right and wrong. gay bashing is just as wrong as racial or religious bashing. And I want to tell you some people are worried about the internet by people getting information on safer sex and gays on the internet and everything else. They're worried about their little kiddies. I'm gonna tell you something. Recently, as a result of this suicide out there in California, they found out that the hate groups their membership with on the internet is growing at 75% greater than ever before. Wow. And rather than worrying about whether your kid is getting safe sex information, we need to be worried about whether these kids are turning out to be hate mongers of tomorrow. No kidding. And that's the real danger and that's why we need a hate crimes bill passed.
