First, we're considered a a charity of last resort. But by doing that, we also have never run out of money. We're one of the hardest agencies in town to get help from most of the agencies that accept government funds are help anybody who is HIV positive, we only help people who are fully disabled from from the AIDS virus.

Then we also have the stone soup fund which provides the meat and produce for AIDS Foundation, Houston stone, soup, food pantry, and people with AIDS. And we provide meat we have provide produce. And on occasion, we provide non food items as well. The people that shopping there, for the most part, qualify for food stamps, but unfortunately, food stamps don't buy certain little necessities like toilet paper and, and aluminum foil and shaving cream and bug spray and a few other things that people need other lives to pay. So occasionally, we have special fundraisers that go to that. So we have a sub fund within the stone soup fund and credit that provides some of those items. Then we have the tilth hacker general charity fund. What that is, I think about the only burial assistance that's available in Houston for people with AIDS, yes. As well as helping other organizations and other individuals that fall through the cracks that don't fit into other into other identified need categories we can help them through till factor. And then with separate bank accounts and separate fund and all we have our working account that pays all the administrative expenses to make sure that we keep all that money separate and the money that's donated into one of the charities stays separate and goes strictly to that charitable purpose with no administrative overhead.
