Also coming up during Pride Week is the gay lesbian, switchboard carnival. And that's going to be on Saturday, June 20. From 11 until five at 1000, Missouri. It's an official event and they are asking for donations of things to help it get going. They want game prizes, costumes, which you can either donate or loan, gift certificates, cash donations, or anything else that would enhance a carnival atmosphere. They're accepting donations through June 15. And it says please search your hearts, your wallet, your store rooms and display counters and help us make this carnival a success.
