The by straights the by buys and the by gay that's by gays and lesbians. So that there are some buys that are very, very close to being straight, but they're still bisexual. There are others that are very close to being lesbian or gay, but they're still bisexual. And then there are those that sort of in the middle that are really by bisexuals. And not more to one side than the other.
