I can now understand why they didn't want this to run in the newsletter. It describes some of the people associated with the Montrose activity center. Andrew Dice Clay will be appearing in Houston on January 17. At the summit, I hope that he receives the same reception in Houston as he did in Dallas. We're a coalition of community organizations such as now and the Gay and Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation convinced sponsors of this homophobic racist, sexist pig comedian to cancel his appearance. We will keep you posted on how this story develops. Hopefully Andrew Dice Clay's reception in Houston will match the weather of the past two days. The National Weather Service is predicting at least 48 hours of below freezing temperatures for Houston and surrounding areas. The Northern Lights appeared in the sky at the darkest time of the night. Against a bleak landscape they're released flashes of brilliantly colored energy. For over four years Northern Lights alternatives has acted as a shining light in the blackness of the AIDS epidemic, the AIDS mastery workshops have helped hundreds of people know that they can live with HIV infection and shine bright. I was a bit of a skeptic. So I began seeking out people who had gone through the workshops. And while my research is not scientific, I concluded that the workshops fill a very important need. The next workshops will be in January, call 4646971 and register. No persons with AIDS or persons with AIDS related complex will be turned away due to lack of funds. Texas born artist Chin will have his National Endowment of the Arts grant reinstated and will proceed with his environmental art project to be planted in Houston. As you may remember, Chin's Grant was revoked. Because of the political nature of his art. Chin plans to plant on sites designated by the EPA to be toxic the plants will remove the toxic heavy metals from the soil, and they will be harvested so that they can be recycled. Within 100 years the sites will be free of toxins as far down as for feed and the land at that point will become habitable once again. Hispanics in the city of Houston will we will begin a fast to point out the need for more Hispanic representation on the city council. Councilman Reyes announced the fast on Thursday. The controversy arose when Judson Robinson's widow was appointed to her deceased husband's Council position. The Hispanics believe that this position should have been appointed to someone among the ranks of their minority. Blacks in Houston have representation on council Hispanics have representation. Gay men and lesbians are not represented on the council in the city of Houston. And as we know, there are almost 200,000 homosexuals in the city. If any Council position is going to be created, it will have to be created for the homosexuals not represented on the city council. I believe that Mr. Reyes and his followers if had confused the

issue, if Mr. Reyes would turn out the vote, he would have more Hispanics on council. The same is true for the gay community. If the gay community would throw their 200,000 votes behind the gay candidate. They would also be represented Mr. Reyes I support you in your fast not because you are morally or politically right. But because you are a little fat cat sitting on council abusing your power. Another group of boys we should keep our eyes on are the National Conference of bishops who recently met in Detroit. In their usual double talk the bishops described homosexuality as a disorder but added that homosexual person is not evil because of his or her sexual orientation. This of course contradicts the 1986 Vatican declaration calling homosexuality and an objective disorder involving a tendency to moral evil. The bishops did a song and dance about the Pope's declaration by adding a footnote which reads homosexual orientation, because it is not freely chosen is not sinful. Despite the about face from the Pope's dictum of 1986 they skirted, not the skirted boys and blacks went on to add that because we believe that according to God's plan, human love can only be manifested or experienced through marriage between a man and a woman. We would say homosexuality is wrong, but the orientation is not sinful. I hope all the good homosexual Catholics are listening to this.

Patients of the Thomas Street Clinic and persons on Medicaid can now choose to receive AZT pentamidine and Bactrim. From the adet clinic pharmacy, an affiliate of the Montrose clinic. According to Ralph Lasher Executive Director last year said that this action has been taken by the Texas Department of Health to relieve overcrowding at the Thomas Street Clinic reduce patient waiting time to pick up prescriptions provide greater convenience to patients and make pharmacy services available during evening hours for persons who work. The Odette clinic will also provide aerosolized pentamidine treatments at no cost for up to 150 persons a month who received this medication from the debt pharmacy. The cost of the nebulizer pre treatment medications sterile water and administration will be paid out of funds donated by the Diana foundation and doofah. Patients will be asked to pay \$5 per prescription just as they are now at the Thomas Street Clinic. Patients covered by Medicaid will not have to pay this fee as it is paid by Medicaid. This fee will be will help cover the cost of operating the pharmacy. The debt clinic will dispense prescriptions Monday through Friday from 10am to 4:30pm and 6pm to 9pm to transfer their AC T pentamidine or Bactrim. prescriptions from the Thomas Street Clinic to the audit clinic patients should call the Texas Department of Health. For more information, call the

clinic at 5285531 and ask for the pharmacy route flasher commented we we agreed to assume this responsibility because we believe will make life better for patients by providing services which are convenient and professional.
