Kimberly Paige Schaefer, PhD mph and co workers at the University of California San Francisco follows 194 HIV negative men, gay men for two years and repeated interviews the men said that their only sexual activity was to perform oral sex on other men. Repeated HIV tests showed that not one of the men got the AIDS virus, even those with HIV infected sex partners. Oral sex is safer sex Schafer tells WebMD it's a much safer alternative to anal sex and other data show that it is safer than anal sex using a condom. Oral sex with a condom may be the safest thing you can do. But 98% of people in our study, don't use condoms. And put and many of them swallowed the semen. And a good percentage of them one in five have sex with HIV positive partners. The men tended to have multiple sex partners have reported more than three in the last six months. So the total number of sex acts over two years was quite large. And many of the men were quite worried that their behavior put them at risk for AIDS. But this fear tended to diminish after multiple HIV tests. Nearly all of them said they hated the taste of condoms. Yeah, sure.
