Well actually read all about it. In the current issue of the Houston press. I think it's what you called bad press that I got. But I learned a long time ago, whenever you get critical media, you don't run away from it, you run toward it. Frank, he taught me a few things, frankly, was my mother. And she taught me a few things about the media. And so instead of running from that article, I would suggest that you read it, it's very interesting that I am the first well funded, openly gay or lesbian or transgendered candidate for public office in Houston history. Well, congratulations, the problem. Let me have a bunch of people at one time, all five, five of us ran at one time. And then of course, there's a nice Parker that's ran and several of us have run for public office. And the several of us have run for public office, but we've never had money we've never taken which seems to be somehow mandatory. And all of this in politics, money is power. If you don't have the money to advertise, and you don't have money to get the kind of thing together. So what I have done is I have found people that looked very familiar to me. I'm talking about people in the adult industry. And the reason those folks look familiar to me is that they have got the police at their neck as well. Many years ago, when the gay and lesbian community was in a situation where we didn't like ourselves, much less one another, and we weren't organized at all, and we need a reason to get organized. We organized around the police boot on our neck, namely Herman short back in the 60s. Name I hadn't heard in a long time. I know. But I remember him well, because I was organizing back in those days. The issue was that they were arresting women who wore fly front trousers. Now it could be Levi's, or it could be a pantsuit that they bought it Isabelle girl Heart if the zipper was in front, those women were going to jail for dressing in the clothing of the opposite sex. People don't understand this in in the late 60s in Houston in the late 60s, at a bar by the name of roaring 60s, which was Rita monsters. By recently, whenever it Austin chatted with Rita and we remembered all those days. Now gay men were getting arrested regularly to they were raiding gay bars all the time. And it was up against the wall mother kind of attitude and all of that. And those people were very concerned.

But gay men thought they were supposed to get arrested. I know that's difficult to imagine now. It's not so hard. But in those days, and it was to the point that I could walk into a gay bar and I never was a drinker. But I couldn't get a Coca Cola, because I was that homosexual that was going to get all those queers into trouble by fighting against the system. And so Okay, thank you. I just keep getting notes. And I'd rather just chat here. And so, so I have found a group of people, the women who work in the topless clubs are among the most police abused people I have ever

experienced. I remember I remember the last time you were here talking about that talking about how you would go, had you been to the some some of the clubs, and the cops would go in there and chased the women chase the women

But I was speaking tonight at the men's club, which is a really ritzy kind of play. Several members of Houston city attorney's office where they're waving at me from the audience, how surprised I mean it and all of those folks that it's a nice crowd, it's an upbeat market, you have to have some money in your pocket to go in there and have a good time. One of the directors of the ACLU from Austin was in town for the weekend. And she and her husband, were at the men's club. Tonight having a wonderful time, they had one of the dancers at their table as a guest, they were having a wonderful time. And you can have a good time there. It's a little expensive for my market. But it's people, people that want to prevent those folks from having good time or just mean that when the cops raided a bar, they arrested one male dancer, for his butt being exposed. Threatened to arrest of the manager for not having a license, sob license, but they arrested 31 female customers.

And some of the folks over to caucus, I screamed at the caucus just day before yesterday, and wonderful folks. But they think that the current acceptance we enjoy as gay people is something that has always been there. And it's real hard for me to explain to them that I have met five men who have been sentenced to life in prison for being gay. In Texas, under the old sodomy statute, if you got the third conviction, it was mandatory under the habitual criminal act, that you get life in prison and two of those men were companions from Schneider, Texas from Schneider. And when they got to prison, the prison puts them together. So they live together as a couple in prison. But they couldn't live together as a couple on the outside. And they kept going back to that county or Comanche County. And because they own property there, and they'd go and

property and the sheriff would come out and kick the door down and arrest them. And then whether he actually caught them or not, that would get tried and they would wind up going to prison.
