It takes only the smallest leap of the imagination to conceive of the impeccably repressed BP, not partaking actively but letting Haji have his way, pretending to be asleep, pretending they were just keeping each other warm against the desert cold, pretending it wasn't happening, anything but admitting he was enjoying it. But can we say he should have come out even to himself? He would certainly have been a tormented invert in his time. Oscar Wilde was already disgraced and dying. Would he be a happy gay man today, has repressed sexual energy is almost directly responsible for the dozens of honors that were heaped upon him. Medals, five knighthoods, a baronetcy, the freedom of 11 cities, six honorary degrees and the adulation of millions, especially millions of men and us with whom he could enjoy an intimacy that two of us can. The man he was, would not have given those up for mere happiness.
